Flagler County Schools, in cooperation with various partners, sponsor Step-Up Industries Vocational / Sheltered Workshop. The program is designed to provide services and assistance to qualified mentally and physically disabled persons.

WHAT WE DO

Step-Up provides

vocational work related activities and instruction in basic living skills.



HOW WE DO IT

Local businesses are contacted to provide work for our students who are then paid on a piece-rate basis. Students also receive hands-on instruction in basic daily living skills.

INDIVIDUAL PROGRAMMING

When a student enters the program, he/she will be assessed during the first thirty days. An individualized plan will then be established. The program will provide an individualized plan for services, goals, and progress measurements.

The plan will be reviewed and updated quarterly, and a team meeting will be held annually. Goals and objectives can be modified, added, or dropped as the student's performance indicates.

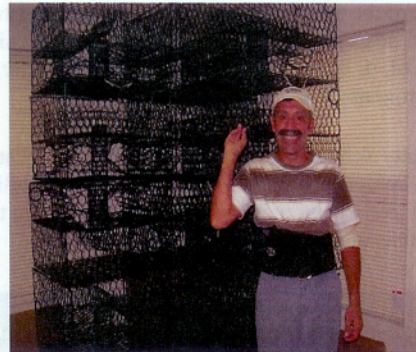
TRANSPORTATION

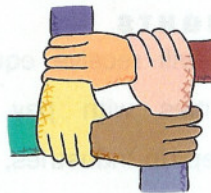

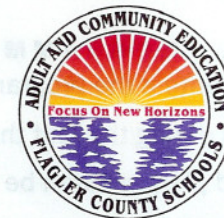
